Thank you for contacting me about federal tax policy. It's good hearing from you.

I appreciate your input on the legislative process. While Congress writes the law, the federal agency with jurisdiction.over a specific law must promulgate regulations to flesh out that law and make it work in practice. As you know, the Internal Revenue Service (IRS), in IRS Publication 1828, has declared that churches are not required to register as not-for-profit organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code (IRC). Further, a donor can make a charitable donation to a non-registered church and still itemize that donation as a deduction. These details are not specified in the IRC, but the IRS publication on this matter is understood as the official interpretation of the IRC, treasury regulations, and court decisions. Rest assured I will keep your thoughts firmly in mind.

- 2. Investigate measures and methods for the simplification of tax.es
- 3. Make reports on the results of those investigations and studies and make recommendations
- 4. Review any proposed refund or credit of tax.es in excess of \$2,000,000.
